



Haridwar Temple Tour

The city of Haridwar boasts of four main temples that are considered to be must-visit destinations. These temples include the Chandi Devi temple, the Mansa Devi temple, the Maya Devi mandir and the Daksh Mahadev temple of Kankhal.


To make the most of your visit to Haridwar, we offer a half-day guided tour that will take you to all of these temples. Our knowledgeable guides will provide you with valuable insights into the history and significance of each of these temples, making your visit an enriching experience. Join us on this tour and discover the spiritual and cultural heritage of Haridwar.

Duration: 3-4 Hours

Kimsar Forest and Mountain Drive

We will take you on a breathtaking journey through the Haridwar and Rishikesh regions. Our adventure begins in an open Jeep with a 15 km drive through the Rajaji Tiger Reserve's buffer zone, along the Upper Ganga Canal. We will then drive 12 km through a dense Sal forest, which leads to a picturesque mountain drive that takes us over 3500 ft in the hills. Along the way, we will pass by a beautiful Banyan tree forest, also known as the Mowgli tree forest. Once we reach the hill-top, on clear days, we will be able to see the plains of Hardwar and Rishikesh, as well as the Ganges from above. This spot is perfect for an unforgettable sunrise and sunset experience. If we're lucky, we might even spot some amazing wildlife along the way.


Offbeat Holy Tour

A tour that takes you through the lesser known but hidden gems of Haridwar's spiritual side.

Guided Tour of Rishikesh

Our guided tour includes a visit to the twin suspension bridges that connect the banks of the Ganga river - Laxman Jhula and Ram Jhula. These suspension bridges are surrounded by a variety of handicraft shops, cafes, and restaurants, making it a delightful experience. We will also visit the Bhootnath temple and the Beatles Ashram, which are significant tourist spots. To conclude our tour on a spiritual note, we will attend the world famous evening Ganga Aarti at the Parmarth Niketan Ashram, which is a must-see event.

Wildlife Safari at Rajaji National Park

Come and experience the thrill of a wildlife safari in one of the most renowned wildlife sanctuaries in India - Rajaji National Park. This region is home to a diverse range of wildlife species including elephants, tigers, leopards, himalayan black bears, sloth bears, various bird species, and a variety of prey such as spotted deer, sambhar, wild boar, barking deer and goral. Rajaji National Park is a great destination for wildlife enthusiasts and bird watchers as it offers a unique opportunity to witness the beauty of nature up close and personal. Park is open from 15th November to 15th June.



Jhilmil Jheel Conservation Reserve

Jhilmil Jheel is a lesser-known wetland located on the left bank of the River Ganges in the Chiriyapur forest range of Haridwar district. It was declared as India's first conservation reserve by the Honorable Former President of India, Prof. Abdul Kalam, on August 14, 2005. The area boasts of a diverse range of flora and fauna, including four species of deer (Chital, Sambar, Barking deer and the specially protected Swamp deer), Wild Elephant, Nilgai, leopard, tiger and a large number of residents as well as winter migratory birds. You can enjoy the panoramic view of the wetland from a watchtower that is well-situated in the area.

Duration: 3-4 Hours (Open Jeep)





Vindyavasini Temple and Picnic Tour

We will glide along the Ganga canal which is located at the edge of the Rajaji National Park. Then, we will take an uncharted off-road path to reach the hidden Vindhya Vasini Temple. Our journey will continue with an open jeep trail through a dry riverbed which has a tri-junction of streams that leads us to the temple. After visiting the temple, we will have a family picnic in the serene wilderness.

Duration: 3-4 Hours



Mystical Trails: Nomadic Village Tour

On the outskirts of Haridwar, within the buffer zone of the Rajaji Tiger Reserve, there are several small nomadic settlements. These settlements provide a glimpse into the simple life and take you back in time. We will take you to one such settlement, which belongs to the tribe of nomadic water buffalo herders known as Van-Gujars. Here, you can observe their way of living and understand the hardships they face.

They have no access to electricity, networks, schools, hospitals or permanent houses. These nomadic people survive by rearing cattle and selling fresh milk to the city of Haridwar.


