INTRODUCTION

Guests also get to enjoy the lush jungle with a choice of a jeep safari, boat safari and walking safari - for explorers to experience the beautiful outdoors, where they might sight the Great Hornbill, Ruddy Shelduck, and approximately 68 species of mammals in the heart of the jungle. The Taj Safari brand is a luxurious hidden treasure overlooking the Rapti river and facing the Chitwan National Park in central Nepal. The park is a world heritage site and is one of the best wildlife viewing national parks in Asia. DINING

BADA GHAR DINNER

In Tharu culture people live in joint family groups in a large family home or the 'Bada Ghar' (literally meaning big house). The Bada Ghar dining at Meghauli Serai is based on this concept of warmth and camaraderie over a meal. The large dining area comfortably seats all guests in the lodge. The a la carte menu offers a selection of options from traditional as well as international cuisines.

RIVERSIDE DINNER

An elevated deck called the Rapti Kinara (literally meaning bank of the Rapti) with a vantage view of the river below and the forest beyond is a most enjoyable alfresco dining spot.

BUSH DINNER

Dine in the wilderness set inside the lodge, an ancient ritual of sitting together with friends after sunset and sharing meal as the stars begin to flicker above you while the night animals begin their chorus. Team will setup the place with oil lamps and candles while the culinary team curate menu which is cooked using wood fire. Enjoy local folk music as we serve a round of non alcoholic welcome drink.

Enjoy the fine evening under the stars with the shimmering lights well decorated on the heli-pad, with mouth watering delicacies prepared just for you.

MEGHAULI ROOM

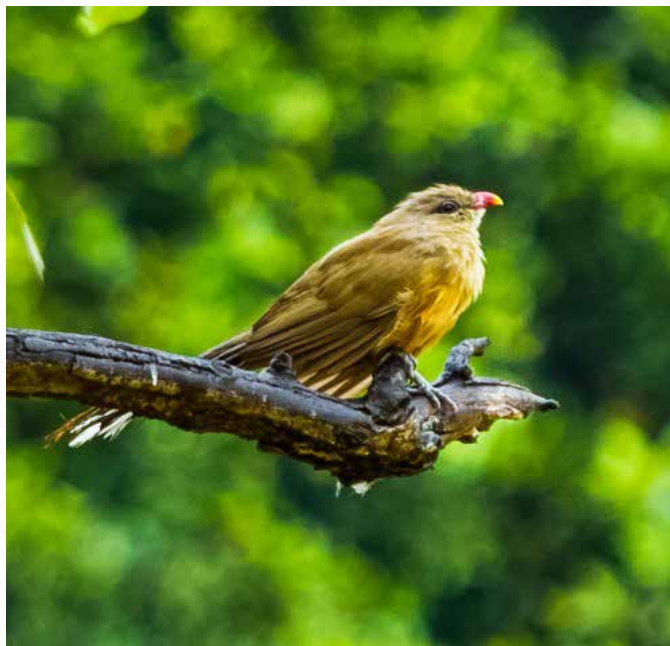
EXPERIENCES

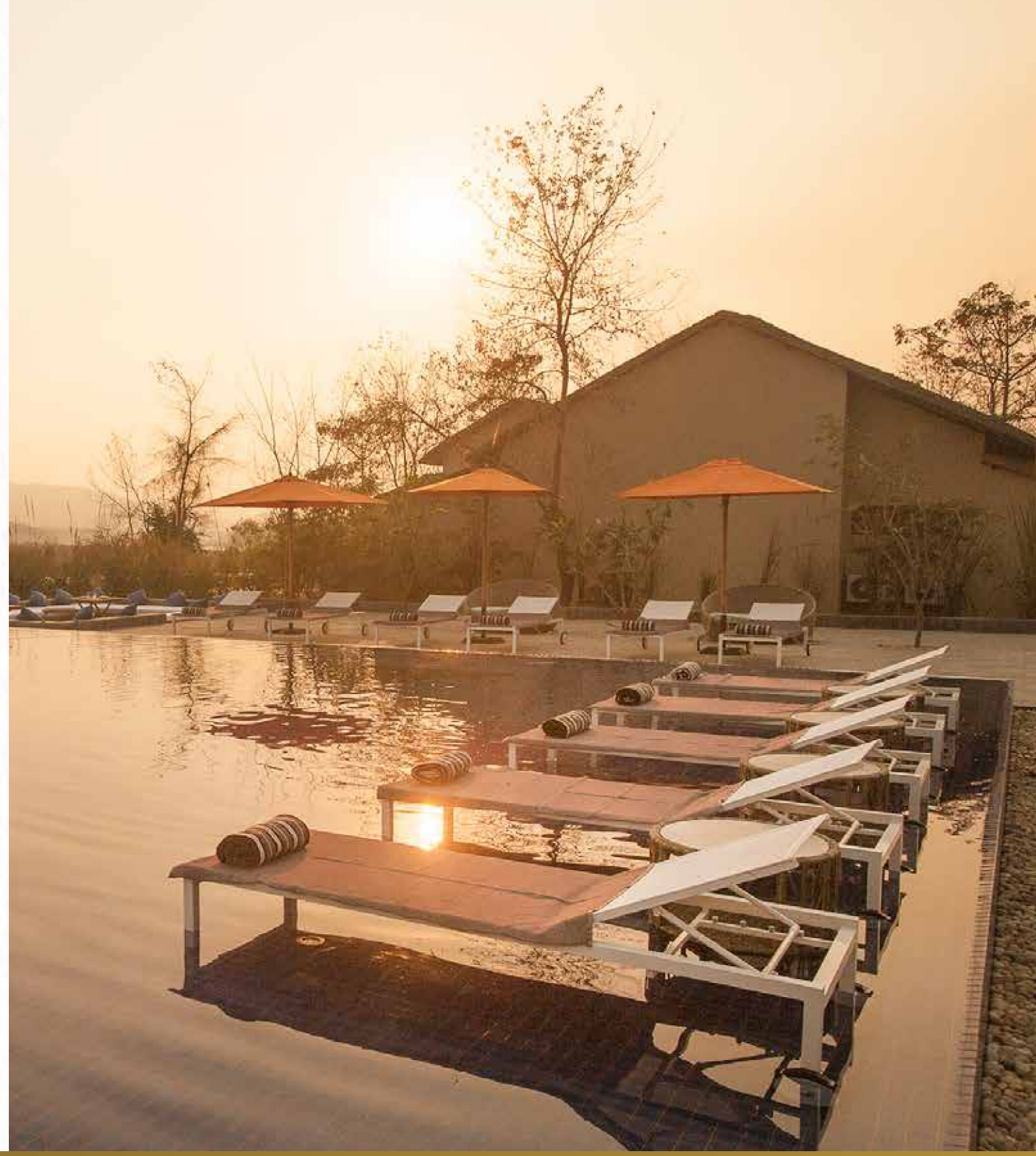


DRIVE AND DINE
