HERITAGE ROOM

The Heritage Rooms, 38 sq. mt in size, delicately balance the past and present with their rustic environment outfitted with modern conveniences. They charm with luxurious twin beds and little details that evoke a heritage.





HERITAGE SEA VIEW ROOM

Sunlight streams in through the square glass window and beckons you to look at the glittering blue sea. On a canvas of earthy wood and delicate cream, the 38 sq. mt room is reminiscent of a cozy parlour. Get charmed by the twin beds and artful décor.







GRAND LUXURY HERITAGE SUITE

A classic reimagined, across a generous 109 sq. mt with a style reminiscent of the 1930s, the suite presents objets d'art, art deco interiors complete with a spacious living room and sea views that astound. Indulge in its creature comforts.

LUXURY SUITE WITH PLUNGE POOL

The Luxury Suite promises 60 sq. mt of artful indulgence, inspired by the maritime grandeur and history of Willingdon Island. Objets d'art and plush upholstery pepper the suite while a private plunge pool feels like one with the backwaters.

PRESIDENTIAL SUITE

In the corner, perched above the lobby is the regal 109 sq. mt Presidential Suite. Having hosted many dignitaries including heads of states it comes with a legacy of its own including a spacious living room, works of art, handmade carpets, a King bed, and large balcony where the breeze brings in the fragrance of Frangipane.









LUXURY SEA VIEW ROOM TOWER BLOCK

The Sea View room showcases expansive views of gentle waves kissing the shoreline. With ridged wall detailing and burnished fixtures, this 26 sq. mt room encapsulates luxury with a king-size bed from where you're treated to a delightful view of the Vembanad and Periyar waters.

DELUXE ROOM TOWER BLOCK

Tasteful details and muted tones of the Deluxe room aren't just cozy, they're intentionally subdued to not takeaway from the surroundings in these 26 sq. mt residences. Botanical art prints, an immaculate marblewashroom and a distinctive maritime influence beguile you indoors while the large windows catch a view of a bustling harbour.

Large windows from where you can see the daily flurry of the harbour is just one of the treats of this 26 sq. mt room. Handsomely done up, the space gives you beautiful sunset views and a gorgeous oceanic decor. While swaddled in the king size bed, the corner of your eye catches Bolgatty or Thopumpady.





SIGNATURE SUITE WITH BALCONY Tower Block

Upholding the coastal aesthetic, the 52 sq. mt luxurious Signature Suite opens into a splendid living room with an attached bedroom and glass doors that lead to the wide balcony. Step out for the sweet sea breeze and the magnificent sights of the shipyard and the shoreline.









GRAND LUXURY SUITE WITH Balcony, Tower Block

At the apex of the Tower Block lies the 78 sq. mt Grand Luxury Suite and it lives up to its name. This swanky accommodation houses a suite room with an extra room and en-suite bath. Many dignitaries, most notably Prince Charles, stayed in this room to commemorate their visit to the city of Fort Kochi.





PEPPER

Named after the 'Black Gold' that made Kerala an indomitable figure in the spice trade, Pepper Restaurant covers a spacious area. Encased in glass walls that give you a lovely view of the water and Dolphin Point, the restaurant serves an expansive menu of Indian and Continental cuisine including authentic Kerala dishes, made from scratch. It holds an open kitchen with collapsible walls to suit the occasion.

DINING

RICE BOAT

Two quintessential elements of Kerala, the cuisine and the houseboat, come together to create this iconic restaurant experience. With an open kitchen, the structure is moored on the edge of the water and you feel like you're enjoying a meal while cruising through the backwaters. With generations of tastemakers of Kerala, here fresh seafood is laced with hand-pounded spices and made with classic recipes.







MATTANCHERRY BAR

Probably Cochin's favourite watering hole, the Mattancherry bar is a draw for its concoctions as much as its effervescent bartenders who remember the regulars' choice by heart. Coated in rich brown warmed by a champagne glow, the ambience is intimate and luxurious. If you don't sink into the chairs, you can sit by the onyx bar counter and catch a glimpse of the water as you take in the inventive cocktails the space's high-spirited camaraderie.

DOLPHIN POINT

If you'd prefer the breeze and open sky as companions to your meal, look no further than Dolphin Point. At the edge of the lawn, you can enjoy an al fresco meal as you gaze across the shoreline. Particularly known for its barbeque and grills, Dolphin Point is lovingly named because you might witness a playful dolphin bobbing up. Enjoy refreshing drinks and generous grilled fare redolent with spice and love.

BRISTOW HALL

The second meeting room seats 12 people. Abundant natural light and an enviable view of the Eastern Himalayan range inspire the proceeding and make this space ideal for brainstorming sessions, executive meetings, and strategising.



RAJA VARMA HALL

Spread across 346 sq. mt of elegance, the Raja Varma Hall is one amongst the trinity of venues at the Taj Malabar. A regal and dignified ambience, it can take in 150 - 200 people. The capacious hall accentuated with wood and cream is warmed by glorious chandeliers.







POOLSIDE LAWNS

Probably one of the most ethereal spaces in Kochi for celebrations and soirees is the 930 sq. mt space of Lawns facing the backwaters at the Taj Malabar Resort & Spa. With a reception style capacity for 200 people, these manicured lawns along the waterfront offer you a venue for memorable weddings.

WILLINGDON HALL The Willingdon Hall accommodates 80 people. The capacious halls accentuated with wood and cream are warmed by glorious chandeliers. They are outfitted with collapsible walls to separate or largen the space for meetings, conferences, weddings and other celebrations.

HERITAGE WALK AT FORT Cochin & Matancherry

Fort Kochi is a living, breathing reminder of the multicultural heritage of Kerala. Traditional architecture is buttressed with European and Colonial influences and creates a unique atmosphere. You breathe in history as you visit St Francis Church - the oldest European Church in India and the original burial spot of Vasco Da Gama. Pass by the Chinese fishing nets believed to be introduced by Chinese explorer Zheng He. Visit the Mattancherry Palace and walk into quaint markets.

SUNSET AT THE JETTY

It's also a beautiful spot where the sky paints an ethereal sunset and is set against a sprawling view of the water and ships. KERALA BOAT TOUR

Taj Malabar faces the point where the Vembanad and Periyar meet at the mouth of the Arabian Sea. This confluence deserves nothing less than a serene boat tour with the coastal air making waves in your hair. As you cruise along, you can also enjoy the panoramic views of historic Mattancherry and Vypin. If you're lucky, you might just encounter a dolphin that might pop up along the ride and really make your journey. You could also pay a visit to Bolghatty Island, a picturesque little island in the Ernakulam district.







KUMBALANGI Homestay experience Experience a beautiful homestay life at Sherly's Ente Kumbalangi, a lovely 6-bedroom bungalow.
